**Early** (Age 60-74)

### Sample Early Retirement Costs:

Two-Week Vacation to Europe - \$3,960/person<sup>3</sup> One-Week Vacation to Hawaii – \$3,365/person<sup>4</sup> National Average Monthly Mortgage Payment - \$1,2005



Mid (Age 75-84)

### **Sample Mid Retirement Costs:**

Gifts to family – \$15,000/year<sup>6</sup> Country club membership – \$6,240/year<sup>7</sup>



**Late** (Age 85+)

#### Sample Late Retirement Costs:

Average medical costs – \$300,000/year<sup>8</sup> Nursing home care – \$290/day9


